

Figure 11 presents the number of offenders under all forms of correctional supervision in West Virginia (i.e., probation, parole, jail, and prison) per 100 citizens.

Findings: The proportion of the population under correctional supervision is significantly lower in West Virginia than in the average U.S. state. However, the proportion of the population under supervision is growing at a faster rate in West Virginia (3.3% per year) than in the average U.S. state (2.5% per year).
